

Catch-Up Premium 2016-17

The catch-up premium is given to the school to provide support for Year 7 students who were “working towards” the expected standard at the end of key stage 2 in English and/or maths. The funding is used in a variety of ways to accelerate progress in literacy and numeracy and close the attainment gap between the group of catch-up students and their peers.

There were 32 students receiving catch-up premium for mathematics and 37 student’s for English. Of these students there were 20 who received funding for both mathematics and English.

By the end of Year 7, 75% (24/32) of the students within the mathematics (numeracy) catch-up group were now working at the expected standard. Within English (literacy), by the end of Year 7 73% (27/37) of the students within the catch up group were now working at the expected standard.

In the 2015-16 cohort, 49 students (41%) receive catch-up premium.
