Justice in a Day 2018 – Drama Education Workshop Monday 19th March, 2018

Working in partnership with Theatr Clwyd, and utilising their expertise in youth education and applied drama, students from Mary Webb School have been invited to take part in a series of workshops at Shrewsbury College of Arts and Technology (London Road). The workshops are intended to provide young people with an insight into the workings of the Criminal Justice System through an interactive and thought provoking day.

The workshops have been developed in partnership with Theatr Clwyd, North Wales Police, HM Courts, Magistrates and Youth Justice Service and will be delivered by professional actors from the Theatr Clwyd. Travel will be to and from school by coach. There is no cost to the student for this visit.

The workshops are designed to encourage young people to make the right choices in life and avoid becoming involved in the Criminal Justice System through making a rash choice or action. During the day they will focus on the negative impact that a criminal action can have on an individual, a victim, their families and the wider community.

The timetable for the day is below:

8.50	Leave School
9.30	Schools arrive – Workshop warm-up
10.00	Interactive Workshop Session 1
11.00 – 11.15	Break
11.15 – 12.00	Interactive Workshop Session 2
12.00 – 12.45	Lunch and walk to court
1.00 – 1.45	Sentencing in Court
1.45 – 2.00	Walk back to venue
2.00 – 2.30	Final summing up
2.30	Return to school.

The workshops are not intended to target young people, but are designed to encourage discussion and to help them become more informed about the consequences of anti-social actions and criminal actions.

Students will be expected to be in school uniform and bring their own packed lunch and a drink. Students who are in receipt of free school meals can order a packed lunch from the school kitchen by completing the request on the reply slip. Students should bring a suitable coat to wear for the short walk from the venue to the Magistrates Court. The short walk to the Court building will be supervised at all times. We expect students to behave in an appropriate manner as they would on the school premises.
