Dear Parents/Carers

Following on from previous successful visits, we are again this year, planning our annual trip to the Battlefields and Trenches of World War I.

Working with Belvidere School, we plan to take a joint trip of our Year 9 students to see some of the famous battlefields, trenches, cemeteries and memorials all related to the First World War.

We shall leave on Thursday 14th March 2019 and return in the early hours of the morning on Sunday 17th March 2019.

The main focus of this educational visit is to enhance and broaden each student's depth of knowledge and awareness of the events of World War I and with this in mind we have devised an itinerary centred on providing a range of visits that will challenge the students' perceptions of war. This will hopefully create a fulfilling and rewarding experience, as well as allowing them to take witness the places associated with World War I first hand.

We shall concentrate our studies around two key areas; firstly Ypres in Belgium, visiting a range of museums, cemeteries and trench reconstructions as well as experiencing the Last Post ceremony at the Menin Gate – a British Memorial to the missing. The second day concentrates on the Somme area of Northern France looking at some of the sites there including the imposing Lochnagar crater at La Boiselle.

The total cost of the tour is £265.00. This price includes the following:

- Travel by executive coach from Shrewsbury and return.
- Ferry crossings to and from France and transport around the area.
- Fully comprehensive travel insurance.
- A range of education materials including an individual diary for each student.
- Two nights' accommodation in a purpose built centre run by the leading educational travel company, NST.
- Evening meal at the centre on Thursday, breakfast, lunch and evening meal in a restaurant on Friday followed by breakfast and lunch on Saturday.
- Entrance fees to the following places:
 - 1) The original trenches of Hill 62 just outside Ypres
 - 2) Entrance to 'In Flanders Field' exhibition, a multimedia interactive exhibition about World War I.
 - 3) A visit to Passchendaele Museum.
 - 4) A visit to Vimy Ridge.
 - 5) Visits to British, German, French and Canadian War cemeteries.
 - 6) Taking part in The Last Post Ceremony held each evening at the Menin Gate in Ypres. Students will also lay a wreath here.
 - 7) A visit to the Lochnagar Crater at La Boiselle. Students will lay a wreath here.
 - 8) A visit to the Thiepval Memorial.

As well as all the historical visits we also arrange for students to spend time at the accommodation centre which is equipped with a games room, a floodlit football pitch and comfortable, safe bedrooms in which students can relax.

We also give the students the opportunity to explore the historical town of Ypres and enjoy some of the delicious Belgian waffles and chocolates on offer there!
