## Celebrating Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Year 9 STEM Curriculum Day on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2019

Year 9 students will be taking part in a series of workshops as part of our STEM Curriculum Day. The day is designed to showcase how science, engineering, technology and mathematics impact on our everyday lives, and shape our daily decisions. They will have a chance to meet a range of Maths Ambassadors – people who use Maths in their everyday jobs – with time to ask questions and find out more about a wide variety of careers.

In addition to this, they will be taking part in a half day of P.E. activities linked to STEM. We are very excited to tell you that 'Ramped' will be joining us. This is an initiative run by Shropshire Council Youth Service. They will be setting up a full skateboard / BMX park in the yard here at school for the day. Each Year 9 student will have a chance to have a go. Students are encouraged to bring in a skateboard, BMX bike, scooter or roller-boots if they have them, also they will need to wear a helmet. All equipment brought in by students will be subject to safety checks by Ramped staff. If students have their own helmet, please bring it; if not, they can borrow one. Ramped will bring in some boards and bikes for students to use. In order for your child to take part in this part of the day, we need you to complete the consent form which accompanies this letter.

This event will take place in school. Students need to wear uniform as usual and bring their P.E. kit – **tracksuit bottoms and a long-sleeved shirt are essential for the Ramped session.**
