## Induction Evening - a Welcome to Mary Webb School and Science College for parents/carers Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> July 2019, at 7.00 pm

I am writing to invite you to visit the school on the evening of Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> July. Earlier in the week, Monday and Tuesday, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> of July, your child will have had his/her induction days at Mary Webb School and Science College. I will have also been out to meet your child in his/her primary school. Therefore, we are running the Induction Evening for parents and carers only.

It is important to us that all parents and carers are able to come to this evening event. If you have childcare issues for children of Year 6 age and above, we will have a supervised area at school for your child to bring an activity to do whilst you are at the meeting. Please complete the slip below if you will need supervision for your Year 6 child during the evening. Please also complete the purple data form that was handed out from your child's primary school recently and return both to your child's primary school so they can be forwarded to us by Friday 21st June.

On arrival at the school, please sign in with our senior students and then gather in the school hall for an introductory talk and meeting with Mr Lowe-Werrell, Headteacher.

Following this, you will be able to:

- meet with your child's form tutor; collect starter information and meet key members of staff to ensure a smooth transition to Mary Webb School and Science College;
- arrange to rent a locker £15 for the full five years please bring cash or a cheque with you if you wish to rent a locker;
- discuss instrumental music lessons with Shropshire Music Service;
- meet the school governors and members of staff who will be available to answer any questions you may have;
- meet with Mr Davies, Assistant Headteacher and the school's SENCo and Mrs Mould, Head of Personalised Learning, Transition and Assistant SENCo;

A pack with pencil-case, dictionary, grammar book and scientific calculator for your child will be given out during the evening. If looked after, these could see your child through to their GCSE exams. This comes to around £25 per child. At Mary Webb School and Science College, we do not operate a 'school fund' so if you wish to make a donation towards this, please bring a contribution on the evening.

Refreshments and tastings will be provided by Shire Catering.

## Induction Days for Year 6 students Monday 1<sup>st</sup> and Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2019

Your child will be spending two induction days with us. We ask that s/he wears his/her primary school uniform and brings the necessary equipment, e.g. pen, pencil, rubber, ruler etc. S/he will also need primary school PE kit, trainers, sunhat and sunscreen for practical team-building activities on the Tuesday. S/he will also need his/her inhaler if s/he uses one.

Your child will be registered with our biometric 'fingerprint' school dinner system on their first day with us. If you would like to talk about this further, please email me. A complimentary meal will be provided by Shire Services on both induction days; your child may bring a packed lunch if s/he prefers.

Arrangements have been made with the local coach companies and your son/daughter may take advantage of free transport on the most appropriate school bus for the induction days if s/he wishes. Alternatively, you are asked to ensure that your child arrives at reception for 8.40 am and that s/he is collected promptly at 3.15 pm. Please send your transport application form directly to Shropshire Council.
