Year 10 and 11 Drama - A Taste of Honey at Wolverhampton Grand Theatre Wednesday 6th November, 2019.

As part of the GCSE Drama course, our students are required to experience a live theatrical production. This is an opportunity for students to witness a professional production in order to more effectively respond to a question worth 20% of their overall grade on the final written examination in Year 11.

In order to enhance knowledge and understanding of how theatre is developed and performed, I have booked a pre-show professional workshop 'Page to Stage' where the students will have the opportunity to work with the director and cast members to appreciate the process of creating a theatrical performance. The students will then take their seats to see the critically acclaimed, National Theatre production of the play, which has recently been on in the West End in London.

The pre-show workshop will begin at 11.00 am at The Wolverhampton Grand Theatre, we will therefore be leaving school at 9.15 am, in order to allow plenty of time to arrive at the venue. Following the pre-show workshop, the students will then have lunch. The matinee performance begins at 2.30 pm, which means that your child will return to school at approximately 6.30 pm. Please could you arrange to collect them at this time?

The trip is during the school day on Wednesday, 6th November, 2019. Students will need to wear school uniform. Students will also need to bring a notepad and pen to make notes on the performance. Students will be responsible for their own belongings both on the coach and at the event. Students are required to bring a packed lunch and a drink for the day.

In order for the trip to go ahead you are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £25.00 which includes the entrance ticket to the event and return travel by coach. We must, however, inform you that as the school could not bear the whole cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless all parents/carers who are able, are willing to contribute. If you find it difficult to meet the cost, you are invited to contact the School Business Manager in confidence to discuss payment. Students who receive free school meals will be supported through funds allocated to the school.
