Dear Tutors and Parents

Please see our general notices on the 2nd page of this newsletter. You may have seen these before, but please could we ask that you remind all students (and parents) of these rules and procedures to ensure health and safety, safeguarding and correct role-call requirements within school are met.

Medication

Please can we remind parents that **students are not permitted to keep medication** on their person or in their bags unless it is an asthma inhaler or epipen.

No Paracetamol, Ibuprofen or any other medication should be brought into school for personal use without our knowledge.

If regular medication is needed, a consent form must be completed and the medication stored in the school office for administering under supervision and safe keeping.

Should your child feel unwell during the day, we have a supply of pain relief in school that we can offer after phoning parents to obtain verbal consent.

Please support us with this important procedure.

If students **feel ill at school**, they must speak to the teacher of their current lesson who will send the student to reception for contact home **if necessary**. Only Key Stage leaders-Miss Pugh or Mr Jervis can give permission for students to be sent home if they are feeling ill.

Students should not contact home themselves to request collection by parents or to get parents to ring school requesting medicines. Contact home should only be made by staff members in these circumstances.

If your child's medical needs or diagnosis has changed, please inform us immediately. It is imperative we keep this information up to date for health and safety reasons.
